Keys are over the Bathroom door in case it is inadvertently locked.

The above lock should be changed as it is too easy to inadvertently leave and lock it, there is an inside slide lock for privacy.

The water heater should be drained and the timer removed as no one uses the emergency shower feature.

We need a volunteer to turn the bath/hangar water off in winter and on in spring - the water valve box is near the bathroom.

The trees at the north end need removal once again.

The hangar electrical bill payor is unknown; each unit should pay a share; the county may assess those hangars that they rent.

No one seems to be interested in volunteering as an officer for the Trinity County Pilots Association so I will continue as long as I can; let me know if you wish to volunteer. I am unable to do much there as I have retired to Sun City AZ. It is best to reach me on email. A special thanks to the pilot volunteers to the county airports committee including Mike Sumner for Hayfork. As usual I was unable to get the county airport official meeting minutes but they are normally posted on the Trinity County Department of Transportation website.
