Trinity County owns and maintains five rural airports: Weaverville, Trinity Center, Hayfork, Hyampom, and Ruth.

Our airports provide:

- Safety and protection via local law enforcement, fire fighting, and air ambulance service access to remote areas
- Education for new pilots who may, one day, be our major air carrier and military pilots
- Viable transportation centers that attract business people and tourists from other areas. Cargo deliveries, business flights, and charters connect Trinity communities to metropolitan economies.
- Access to some of the most beautiful country and friendly communities in northern California

Trinity County airports, like most airports, are primarily funded by user fees and taxes that only pilots and aircraft passengers pay.
